This is particularly the case in areas encompassing family or criminal law where clients need understanding, empathy, and experience from their solicitor.



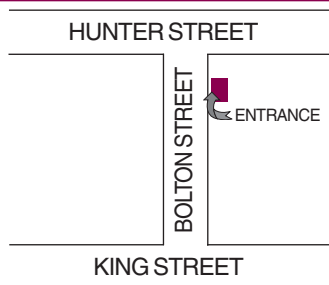
